

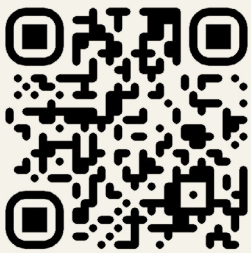

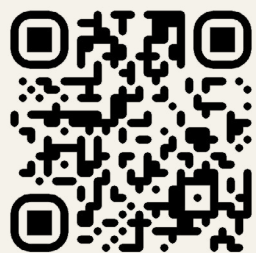

Ramadan Food Program

Our Ramadan Food Program consists of aid distribution during the month of Ramadan. Since the program began, we are honoured to have provided food assistance for more than 50 million people, Alhamdulillah! In 2026, Islamic Relief will be providing food packs to those in need across 33 countries and distribute 222,110 food packs to families that will feed approximately 1.18 million people over the month of Ramadan. We distribute vital food assistance to fasting and non-fasting eligible families throughout the sacred month, and do not discriminate against anyone based on religion, gender, race or ethnicity. The program will prioritise dignity and inclusion and assist on the bases of need alone, regardless of gender, faith, or social background. The program aims to help people

facing food shortages, improve nutrition, and support their economic stability during Ramadan and afterwards.

Islamic Relief Australia has prioritised 17 countries for food aid distribution. These are Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bangladesh (FDMN), Bosnia, India, Indonesia, Ethiopia, Jordan, Morocco, Lebanon, Mali, Pakistan, Palestine (Gaza), Somalia, South Africa, Sudan, Turkey, Yemen.

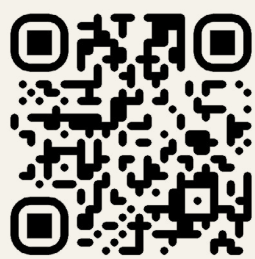

Palestine Emergency Appeal



Islamic Relief has provided over 73 million hot meals in Gaza, made possible by our generous supporters.

Key Situation Overview – Gaza

Widespread devastation: Since October 7th, relentless violence has destroyed thousands of homes, displaced over 1.9 million people, and claimed the lives of more than 61,000 people, nearly half of them children.

Severe food crisis: A prolonged siege and blockade have restricted the entry of food, water, and medical supplies, pushing families into catastrophic levels of hunger. Since the start of the crisis, our teams, alongside local partners, were able to distribute over million of dollars worth of aid and **over 73 million hot meals**.

Famine declared: The IPC has declared famine in Gaza, with 1.1 million people facing starvation, children dying from hunger, and families going days without food or clean water.

Life-saving response continues: Despite immense challenges, Islamic Relief, alongside partners such as PANZMA and UNICEF, continues delivering food, hot meals, medical supplies, winterisation aid, and psychosocial support, remaining a vital lifeline for Palestinian families.

Palestine Emergency Appeal



Through our Gaza Maternal Health Project 1,380 pregnant and nursing women are receiving vital supporting through pregnancy and delivery.

Islamic Relief continues to focus on meeting the everyday needs of our brothers and sisters in Gaza. We are providing food security, health, shelter, non-food items (NFIs), education, water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH) and protection. These are the essentials that sustain life. For months, the people of Gaza have experienced catastrophic levels of food insecurity due to the total siege and blockade enforced by Israel - refusing entry of vital aid such as food and medical supplies. Since the start of the crisis, our teams, alongside local partners, were able to distribute millions of dollars' worth of aid and over 73 million hot meals. More recently, following a slight ease in the blockade, Islamic Relief has been able to successfully resume the distribution of hot meals in Gaza.

Maternity Project - Improving reproductive health of pregnant women and newborns

We are the only organisation providing organised, field-based maternal health services across the Gaza Strip. It is vital to supporting maternal health, reducing the risk of complications during pregnancy and childbirth, and ensuring the healthy development of unborn children. The project has been implemented simultaneously in both northern and southern Gaza Strip. It provides essential prenatal and postnatal care, supported safe deliveries, and distributing essential vitamins. The approach links health, nutrition, and hygiene.



Winterisation

This winter has brought even greater hardship to families in Gaza. Freezing temperatures, heavy rain, flooding, and unsafe buildings have made daily survival even more dangerous, with some children already losing their lives to the cold. Many families, displaced multiple times, are now sheltering in damaged buildings, tents, or under tarpaulins with no heating or protection.

Through our partnership with UNICEF Australia, Islamic Relief is delivering urgent winter support, including warm clothing for children, blankets, family tents, tarpaulins, hygiene kits, and essential sanitation support, helping protect vulnerable families from illness and further harm.



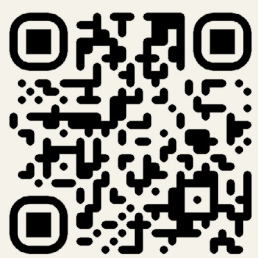
PANZMA Medical Missions

Our partnership with PANZMA has delivered truly lifesaving medical support through the courageous volunteer medical specialists who have gone to work under incredibly difficult and dangerous conditions. Islamic Relief Australia and PANZMA have provided the funding for the logistics, travel, accommodation and medical supplies for the teams. The teams are providing emergency and specialised medical care, major and minor surgeries, post-operative care, triage, and stabilisation services to hundreds of patients. On return the team members have been passionate advocates for the health rights of Palestinians on national international platforms, being able to give firsthand accounts of the situation in Gaza.

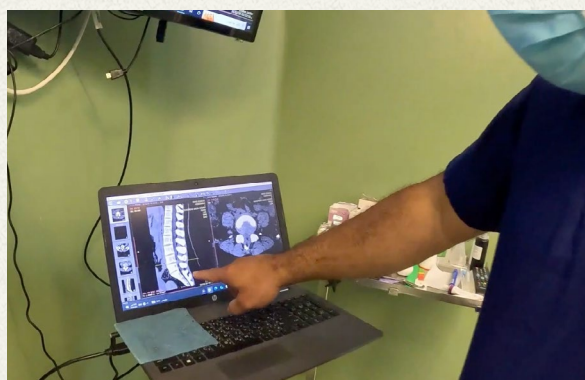

Orphan Sponsorship Program

The ongoing violence in the Gaza Strip has left **39,000 children without parents or guardians to care for them** - an unspeakable tragedy. Through the Orphan Sponsorship Program, Islamic Relief has continued to provide vital support to these vulnerable children, ensuring they have access to necessities such as food, healthcare and psychosocial support to deal with the tragedies they have faced. Throughout the crisis, orphan families have been receiving quarterly cash transfers via a digital banking system which allows them to pay for essentials.

Lebanon Education School Rehabilitation

The project will improve access to quality education and psychosocial well-being for students through safer, better equipped, and more supportive learning environments. The learning environment and student wellbeing in North Lebanon will be enhanced through the rehabilitation and repairing three public schools, transforming them into safer, and more supportive spaces. In addition, 400 students will receive essential stationary kit to facilitate effective learning. In addition to the academic improvement, these interventions are designed to address mental health challenges and create a supportive environment for personal growth. This change will be achieved through a multi-sectoral approach that addresses physical, material, and psychological barriers to learning.

Different students experience different challenges: an increase in student dropouts, adolescent girls are more likely to miss school due to unsafe or inadequate facilities, and students with disabilities struggle with inaccessible infrastructure. Vulnerable and displaced families experience greater financial and emotional strain, heightening dropout risks.

Activities include:

- Improving the infrastructure of three schools
- Supporting the mental health and well-being of 400 students improved through psychosocial support interventions.
- Provide 400 students with essential stationery through provision of school kits.

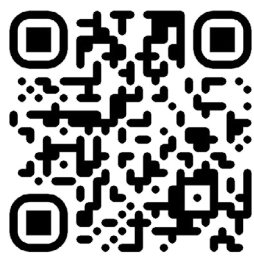

Sudan Emergency Appeal

 Al Jazirah, Gedaref, Sennar and Port Sudan



Since war broke out in April 2023, Islamic Relief has reached over 1.2 million people with life-saving aid.

The ongoing conflict in Sudan has led to untold human suffering. In addition to the physical danger that violent conflict brings, there has been massive displacement, hunger and famine, no access to health care, drinkable water or shelter. The conflict has led to the largest displacement crisis on earth, with over 11.3 million people internally displaced persons (IDPs) and 24.6 million people who are food insecurity. Islamic Relief has dedicated teams in Sudan delivering lifesaving aid in many districts. We are currently delivering lifesaving food assistance to 1,805 conflict-affected households (approximately 9,025 individuals). Our teams are ensuring that vulnerable groups, such as the elderly, chronically ill, children and those with disabilities, have access to adequate nutrition. The food packs have been developed to meet the actual needs of the rightsholders and to ensure that the food is nutritious, culturally appropriate, and easily prepared.

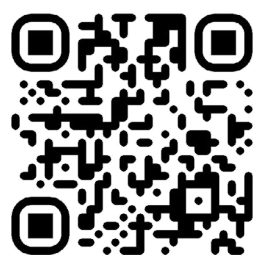

Your support is a vital for families in Yemen

The food crisis in Yemen has been prolonged due to a combination of factors such as conflict, displacement of populations, economic instability, currency fluctuations, rising food prices, climate change hazards, and inadequate access to basic services, continued blockade, no salaries and limited jobs. Orphan families are some of the worst impacted and continue to struggle to meet their basic food requirements due to the ongoing crisis. This food insecurity contributes to heightened stress and instability within households, directly affecting the well-being and development of children. To address these urgent needs, Islamic Relief Yemen will target 200 of the most vulnerable orphaned households in Dar Sa'd district with emergency food assistance. The project will assist 700 individuals.

By focusing resources on this high-risk group, the initiative seeks to address both immediate needs and longer-term vulnerabilities, ensuring a more stable and dignified living environment for orphaned children and their families. The households targeted are experiencing extreme food insecurity, what this practically means is that they have long periods between eating, high malnutrition, and that they are resorting to extreme coping (such as selling assets) just to eat.

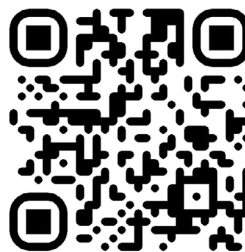
Pakistan Water Supply Systems in Refugee Schools

Lack of safe drinking water and sanitation services is a major development problem in the schools, both in refugee village schools and in host communities in the Peshawar and Nowshera Districts, KP Province. The project will provide WASH facilities to 4 refugee schools. The project involves WASH infrastructure rehabilitation, health & hygiene promotion and education, and capacity building training. The project will reach 1600 students and 40 teaching staff.

Key deliverables include:

- Rehabilitation of existing latrines and washrooms
- Construction of new latrines and washrooms to cover the over crowd
- Rehabilitation of sanitation system
- Installation of solar PV system for water pumps
- Construction of accessible pathways, ramps and railing for PWDs
- Installation/construction of incinerators and solid waste bin
- Existing schools' buildings' minor repair and whitewash
- Water supply system rehabilitation

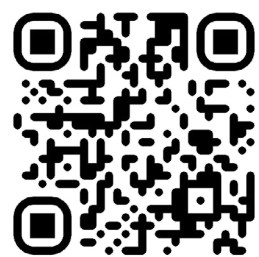

Jordan

Provision of Primary Health Care Services, Jordan

Since 2011, Jordan alone has provided refuge to more than 1.36 million Syrians, 90% living among the local community in Amman and northern Jordan such as Al Mafraq. The geographical location of Al-Mafraq governorate in the centre of Jordan and its proximity to the Syrian-Jordanian border, makes it a key area within which to provide services for inhabitants as well as residents of other major governorates in the north like Irbid and Al-Ramtha.

As of the 31st March 2023, the total number of refugees in Al-Mafraq was 168,950, 26% of the total number of registered refugees in Jordan.

Since the onset of the crisis in Syria, the health sector in Jordan has faced challenges with increased demand on healthcare facilities due to the influx of refugees with not enough bed space. Increased rates of poor health have been reported and 50% of the refugees have had rising health associated costs. In addition, 51% of Syrians are not able to access health services, and 45% of the households have

at least one family member with a chronic illness that affects their daily life. 14% of Syrian families live with a person with a disability. Loss of income and employment for many of these refugees has also decreased access for these families.

Islamic Relief’s teams in Jordan are focusing on preserving access to essential primary health services for the most vulnerable refugees (women and girls at risk during the reproductive period, children, and patients with chronic life-threatening illnesses). The proposed project prioritises meeting the critical needs of the health sector for refugees and local communities in Jordan. The proposed project will contribute to improving the health status of Syrian refugees and local community members, enabling access of the most vulnerable to health care services. The project also aims to release the current pressure on the public health system.

Somalia Eye Cataract

The Somalia cataract project serves to prevent blindness through the provision of comprehensive eye care and free cataract surgery services in rural areas of Somalia. People have improved access to quality; inclusive and comprehensive eye health services is assisting 1300 rightsholders through free cataract treatment and surgery.

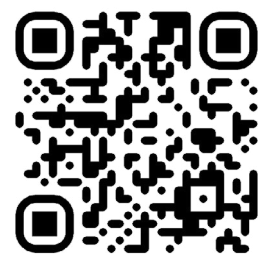
The equipped facility is the centre for cataract campaigns and treatments continuously throughout the year and is the base for this project.

The project activities include:

- Equipping and furnishing one health centre.
- Community mobilisation and cataract screening outreach activities.
- Conduct free screening and medical check-ups
- Conduct 1300 cataract surgery from the initial 800
- Distribute free reading glasses to the patient.
- Monitoring of patient progress.
- Providing postoperative support and treatment.

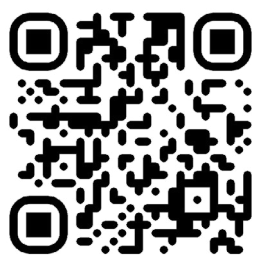

Indonesia Housing

House Construction for Orphan Families and the Needy Families

Many vulnerable households are living in unhealthy and poorly built houses, which are less than 9m² per person, have no latrine, have inadequate lighting, poor air ventilation, high humidity, and no basic services. Considering that Indonesia is prone to disasters, especially to earthquakes, these structures are life threatening.

Islamic Relief Indonesia has joined forces with the various agencies that are dealing with the housing crisis in order to deliver more houses. The houses are high quality, the construction is earthquake resistant, include WASH facilities (latrine, bathing room, water point), the residents also receive household utensils, bedding, furniture, a learning table for students and other features. The project focuses on assisting vulnerable families, including female headed households, families with orphan children, and the very poor. The project serves to improve the wellbeing, reduced vulnerability, and alleviate the suffering of the families through the provision of habitable, safe, and well-constructed houses. Islamic Relief Australia is undertaking the project as an ongoing, multi-year basis, building on average 30 houses per year.

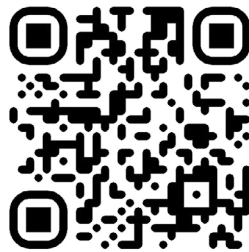
