"I dream of living in a safe place away from the bombing of warplanes."

Six-year-old Sumaya and her family have been searching for safety since war reached their home in Raqqa, Syria.

Fleeing the fighting, they moved from place to place until they reached Zinbq camp, north of Idlib. "I was playing in the camp yard with my friends when suddenly we heard the sound of a plane and ran away from it," says Sumaya. Moments later she remembers "feeling like I was flying in the sky. I do not remember anything more except that I woke up in hospital."

Sumaya spent several months in intensive care, slowly regaining the ability to walk.

"I hope to grow up and become a doctor at one of the physiotherapy centres so I can help the children injured in this war," she says. With your support, Islamic Relief can deliver aid to girls like Sumaya.

Siti used to have to leave home and find dangerous work breaking rocks for sand in quarries far away from her children. She put her own health at risk and spent long hours away to support her family. Now, Siti earns a dignified and sustainable income by cultivating and selling mushrooms in her community thanks to support she has received from Islamic Relief.

"We are happy that we were introduced to mushroom production. With the new skills we have we can take care of our children while earning for the family," says Siti.

Due to the ongoing conflict in Yemen, millions are going hungry. Among those struggling is Ahmad and his 16-month-old daughter Sumaia. "Sometimes, I cannot provide even one meal a day," he says. "It has been very difficult for me to watch my children suffer due to lack of food." Sumaia was underweight and suffering with acute malnutrition until Islamic Relief intervened.

Sumaia was admitted to a health clinic supported by Islamic Relief, where she received urgent treatment. Since beginning treatment, Sumaia's health has improved significantly and her weight has stabilised.

"I am very thankful to Islamic Relief and their donors for providing such free services. You saved my daughter's life and many others. Thank you so much," says Ahmad.


YOUR BELIEF IN ACTION.
